ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2 AS AMENDED, BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS AND RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2 as amended, be amended to read as follows:

That there shall be and there are hereby established rates and charges for the use of and for the water supplied by the waterworks system of the Lakeside Water District, Jackson and Williamson Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Service Charge: All customers shall pay a basic service charge of \$8.00 per month. All customers operating an apartment building or buildings on the premises to which water is supplied shall pay an additional service charge of \$1.00 per month per apartment. All customers operating a trailer court on the premises to which water is supplied shall pay an additional service charge of \$1.00 per month per trailer.

Water Charge: In addition to the service charge, all customers shall pay for water consumed, as shown by the water meters, the following charges: All water shall be at the rate of \$5.50 per thousand gallons.

Minimum Charge: The minimum monthly bill for all customers, including the basic service charge and the water charge, shall be \$24.50. The minimum charge includes 3,000 gallons of water.

<u>Penalty</u>: A penalty of 10% of the total bill shall be added to each account if not paid by the 10^{th} of the month in which the bill is presented. Failure to receive the bill shall not relieve the customer of said penalty.

Section 2: That except as hereby modified and changed, Ordinance No. 2, as amended, shall remain the same and in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>: That within 30 days after its adoption, this Ordinance shall be published in the Southern Illinoisan, a newspaper published in Jackson County, Illinois and of general circulation within the District, and shall become effective ten days after such publication.
