ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2 AS AMENDED, BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES, REGULATIONS AND RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LAKESIDE WATER DISTRICT, JACKSON AND WILLIAMSON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2 as amended, be amended to read as follows:

That there shall be and there are hereby established rates and charges for the use of and for the water supplied by the waterworks system of the Lakeside Water District, Jackson and Williamson Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Service Charge: All customers with a meter less than 1 inch size shall pay a basic service charge of \$12.00 per month. All customers with a meter 1 inch size or larger shall pay a basic service charge of \$60.00 per month.

Water Charge: In addition to the service charge, all customers shall pay for water usage, as shown by the water meters, the following charges: 1) All water shall be at the rate of \$6.38 per thousand gallons. 2) All customers having a meter 1 inch size or larger shall pay a surcharge of 10% on their water usage.

Minimum Charge: The minimum monthly bill for all customers with a meter of less than 1 inch size, including the basic service charge and the water charge, shall be \$31.14. The minimum charge includes 2,000 gallons of water.

The minimum monthly bill for all customers having a meter 1 inch size or larger, including the basic service charge, the water charge, and the 10% surcharge, shall be \$67.02. The minimum charge includes 1,000 gallons of water.

<u>Penalty:</u> A penalty of \$10 or 10% of the total bill, whichever is greater, shall be added to each account if not paid by the 15th of the month in which the bill is presented. Failure to receive the bill shall not relieve the customer of said penalty.

Section 2: That except as hereby modified and changed, Ordinance No. 2, as amended, shall remain the same and in full force and effect.

Section 3: That within 30 days after its adoption, this Ordinance shall be

published in the Carbondale Times, a newspaper published in Jackson County, Illinois and of general circulation within the District, and shall become effective with the June billing.
